Central Review Committee

ARTICLE V.
ADVISORY COMMITTEES OF THE COMMISSION
Section 5.01 Central Review Committee.

(a) Responsibilities. The Central Review Committee shall be an advisory committee responsible for recommending accreditation status to the Board of Trustees.

(b) Composition. Composition of the Central Review Committee shall be determined by the Board of Trustees.

(c) Appointment and Term. Members of the Central Review Committee shall be appointed by the Board of Trustees at the time of the annual meeting of the Commission for a term of three years.

Members of the Central Review Committee may succeed themselves

but may not serve more than two terms.

(d) Procedures. The Board of Trustees, in consultation with members of the Central Review Committee, shall develop procedures for the operation of the Central Review Committee.

Deleted: The Central Review Committee shall be divided into the following subcommittees: Non-public, Postsecondary, Vocational/Adult, Special Purpose, Transitions, and Kindergarten to Grade 12 public schools ("K-12"). The Non-Public, Vocational/Adult, Special Purpose and College Preparatory subcommittees shall include at least two public representatives not currently employed in the field of education and not retired educators. The K-12 subcommittee shall include State/Intra-regional Committee chairs, state review officers, and representatives of the public.
