Section 3.02 Composition.

(b) Regional Representatives. Twenty-one state member representatives shall serve on the Board of Trustees. Such members shall be seated on the Board of Trustees based on membership category as designated by class (year) and state representation. (See Exhibit 1 of these Bylaws for a representative cycle.) The respective state shall move to the next membership category following each three-year term. The membership categories for the Regional Representatives shall be:

- (i) One eligible representative of the state department of education.
- (ii) One eligible representative of a college or university.
- (iii) One classroom teacher from a school accredited by the Commission.
- (iv) ~~One seventh of the representatives on the Board of Trustees shall be~~ representatives of the public not currently employed in the field of education and not retired educators. ~~In the event that the rotation of representation does not provide for this minimum of representation from the public, the Board of Trustees shall appoint an at-large public representative.~~
- (v) Three representatives from each of the following categories: secondary schools, middle level schools, elementary schools, and central office administrators. The three central office administrators will represent small, mid-size, and urban districts.
- (vi) One representative from each of the following categories: non-public schools, adult/vocational schools, and special purpose schools.

At the end of a complete cycle, the six membership categories—teacher,

state department representative, non-public school representative, adult vocational, and special purpose—shall rotate to other groups of states. Regional Representative members of the Board of Trustees shall be nominated by the respective State/Intra-regional Committees (which shall include the Navajo Nation NCA Committee and the Overseas Dependents Schools Committee) for the position designated in that state for that year. The nominee does not have to be a member of the State/Intra-regional Committee. ~~Each~~ respective State/Intra-regional Committee will submit to the Chair or the Board of Trustees by February 1 the name of the person being nominated for the position to be filled from ~~that~~ state. A statement setting forth the person's qualifications will also be submitted. The nominees shall be recorded officially in the Commission office, and a summary of the nominations should be sent to each state office. The Board of Trustees shall act to elect the nominees at the Board of Trustees meeting held at the time of the annual meeting of the Commission.
